#### **ITEMS DISCUSSED**

- 1. General Progress
  - a. Progress To-Date
    - i. Sanitary sewer has been built up to 44<sup>th</sup> St from the intersection of Ridgewood and Madison
    - ii. 3 of the 4 catch basins in the intersection of Ridgewood and Madison have been installed. The NW catch basin remains.
    - iii. Watermain from Ridgewood and Madison to 44<sup>th</sup> St has been installed, passed the pressure test, and is currently undergoing the bacteriological test.

## 2. Sanitary sewer

- a. 2 sanitary laterals remain to be installed on the north end of Julivan
  - One lateral is in conflict with a Consumers pole and will be installed post the pole being moved by consumers.
  - ii. The other lateral needs to wait until the watermain is installed to avoid conflicts.
- 3. Removals
- Storm Sewer
  - a. Pause on installation on Julivan for gas main relocation by DTE. Multiple gas laterals are in the way of the mainline storm sewer.
  - b. Storm MH 113 was approved for the utilize a low-profile casting. Details around the swap of casting to be determined at a later time.
- 5. Watermain
  - a. Pressure Testing Results Passed
  - b. Bacteriological Testing Ongoing
    - Chlorinated water used in the testing to be slowly flushed (under 200 gpm) to the sanitary sewer.

- a. The tree at 4427 is being priced out by the resident for reimbursement by the city due to damage.
- b. The city may suggest a quote from their preferred tree supplier.

    - i. 7 6-inch valves for the hydrants
    - ii. Tree removal at 4427 due to heavier than expected root removal during watermain removal.
