The Bidder shall be responsible for obtaining/downloading all pertinent bidding information to adequately and accurately prepare their Bid.

5. A certified check, bank draft, or bid bond payable without condition to the City of Kentwood in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the Total Bid Amount, shall be submitted as a "Bid Guaranty" as required in the Information for Bidders.

6. The intent of the City of Kentwood is to award one (1) Contract for the entire project.

7. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish bonds and insurance as specified.

8. Bids shall remain firm and shall not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after bid opening.
9. City of Kentwood reserves the right to accept any Bid, to reject any or all Bids, or to waive bidding formalities in the best interest of the Owner.
